Your progress reports are semi-annual and are due in the Grants Management System (GMS) no later than January 30 and July 30 of each year. Your progress report must contain two (2) attachments:

- 1. The narrative Categorical Assistance Progress Report (CAPR) report that explains progress toward your goals.
- 2. A copy of the Performance Measures Tool (PMT) report.
