Vision of Healing to Wellness Court (HWC)

- **Assist the youth in developing and sustaining a strong identification with their language, history, and culture for the purpose of combatting drugs and alcohol use among the community.**
- **By providing the youth access to their language, culture, and history, they will regain a sense of place and belonging with their Tribe and be part of a healthy community. Through highly structured application of services, the HWC team works to instill Tribal values and reintegrate youth into their Tribal community.**

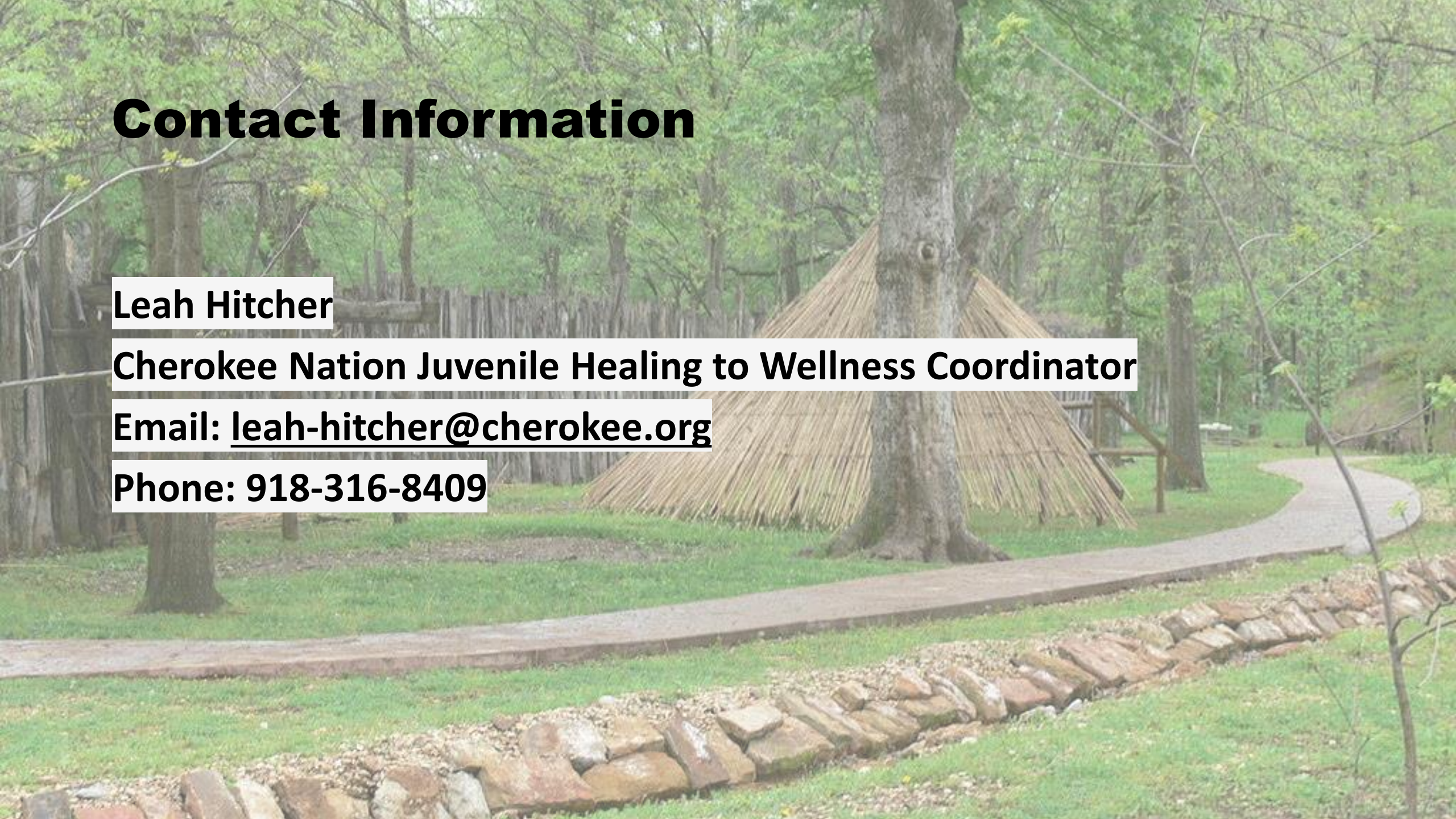
